

Become a AFD Volunteer Firefighter

Albany Volunteer Firefighter:

Albany Volunteer Firefighters will be limited in their functions and do not participate in activities which may require them being in close proximity to any hazardous zone.

Minimum Requirements:

1. No prior training required
2. Complete Georgia Basic Firefighters Course Module – 1 (taught by Albany Fire Department)
3. Minimum 18 years old
4. Submit to a drug test & physical provided by the Albany Fire Department
5. Valid Georgia drivers' license
6. No felony convictions within the past 10 years including any crimes of moral turpitude. (Theft, Child Abuse or Elderly Abuse)
7. Complete the application and privacy act release below and deliver to Albany Fire Department – 320 North Jackson Street, Albany, Georgia

Benefits: State pension and community involvement.

To qualify for the Georgia Fireman's pension fund the applicant must successfully complete the Georgia Basic Firefighters Course Module – 1, enroll in the pension fund and pay the monthly dues of \$15.00.

Once in the pension fund, the volunteer firefighter must continue to pay \$15.00 per month, respond to 50% of the toned out calls and attend 50% of the annual scheduled drills to keep the pension fund active.
