

DOUGHERTY COUNTY COMMISSION

REGULAR MEETING MINUTES

November 3, 2008

The Dougherty County Commission met for its Regular Meeting in Room 120 of the Central Square Government Center on November 3, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. Vice Chairman Jack Stone called the meeting to order. Commissioners present were Lamar Hudgins, Muarlean Edwards, John Hayes, and Chuck Lingle. Also present were Richard Crowdis, County Administrator; Spencer Lee, County Attorney; Barbara Engram, County Clerk; and Nancy Hillsman, Administrative Secretary. Representatives of the media were present.

Vice Chairman Jack Stone opened the meeting. Reverend Jimmy Hagadorn of Trinity Worship Center gave the invocation which was followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

The Vice Chairman called for approval of the October 27, 2008 Work Session minutes.

Commissioner Lingle moved to approve the minutes. Upon a second by Commissioner Hudgins, the minutes were unanimously passed.

The Vice Chairman called for consideration of a resolution authorizing and approving Albany Riverfront and Gateway Tax Allocation Redevelopment Plan. The City adopted the Plan in its Regular Meeting October 28, 2008.

Commissioner Hudgins moved for approval. Upon a second by Commissioner Lingle, the motion carried unanimously. Resolution No. 08-036 is entitled as follows:
